From The HoD's Desk



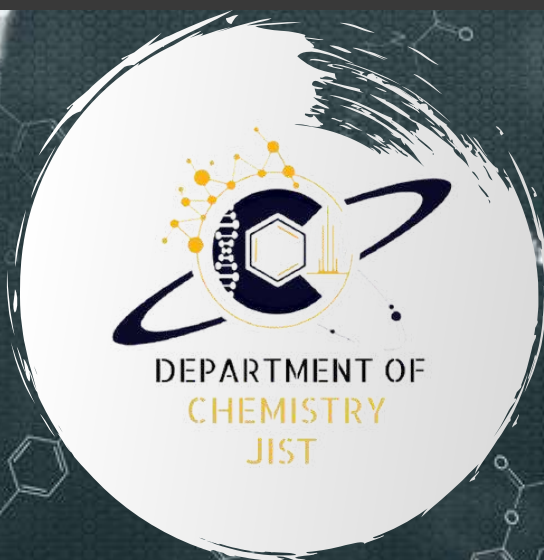
